ORDER

Extension in provisional recognition is granted to Ashiana Public School, Sector- 46A, Chandigarh upto senior secondary level from 1.4.2017 to 31.3.2022 under Article 235 read with 241-A of Punjab Education Code subject to the condition that the school should ensure that all the conditions as given below are complied within six months before the expiry of the extended period of recognition failing which further recognition would not be considered:-

1. Local Managing Committee may be got approved from the education department, UT, Chandigarh.
2. Salary to be paid to the Teachers and other staff strictly as per provision of Appendix-I of CBSE Affiliation by Laws and provident fund of all staff must be made by the school authority.
3. RTE Act/Rules and other instructions issued by the Education Department, Chandigarh administration, in this regard, especially related to admission of students under EWS category and Disadvantaged Groups, may be followed in letter and spirit. Admission for EWS category may be made as per RTE Act.
4. The reserve fund as per provision of Punjab Education code must be pledged in the name of DEO, Chandigarh.
5. Building completion certificate may be submitted by the school.
6. School will follow the provision of Rules of Recognition of Punjab Education Code;
7. School will follow land allotment conditions and other notifications/orders/ instructions issued by the Chandigarh Administration from time to time;
8. No particular book shop be prescribed for purchase of book/uniform etc. by the school;
9. Instructions/guidelines issued by CBSE relating to books/uniforms are to be followed;
10. Fire Safety norms be followed meticulously and there should be no laxity in this regard on the part of school;
11. Fee should be charged from the students as per CBSE Affiliation Bye Laws and receipt be issued to the students against the money charged from them;
12. Staff engaged should be fully qualified and untrained teachers should be replaced with trained ones;
13. Recognition is liable to withdrawn if the Management or the staff of the school take part in agitation directed against the authority of Government, or disseminate opinions tending to excite feelings of disloyalty or disaffection against Government or of enmity and hatred between different classes or if the pupils are permitted to attend political meetings or to engage in any form of political or communal agitation;
14. Government reserves to itself the right, to grant, refuse or withdraw recognition at its entire discretion;
15. School will recruit teachers as per NCTE notification dated 12.11.2014 regarding minimum qualification of teachers including the qualifications prescribed for teachers including the qualifications prescribed for teachers at pre primary level as per letter dated 2.4.2018;
